***Section 18. Active and Advisor Delegates.** For the purpose of defining access to and participation in legislative sessions of the National Convention, delegates are defined as those individuals who have the right to participate (speaking and/or voting) as defined by Article IV of the National Bylaws.

A Chapter Advisor, who has been identified on the most recent Chapter roster or through more recent

Chapter provided documentation, may act as a Chapter Delegate if

- (1) There is no Active Member in attendance at the Convention,
- (2) He/She is properly registered at the convention and
- (3) The Advisor has obtained the Chapter President's signed authorization to be a Voting Delegate on an approved form. The Chapter President may identify one or two Chapter Advisors as eligible to be Voting Delegates.

Petitioning Group Advisors (one or two) may be Delegates if no Student Members are present and the Advisors have been properly identified in this role with documents filed with the National Office. If the National Office has received current information of a Petitioning Group President the policy is the same as for an Active Chapter. Otherwise, if there is no indication from the Student Members as to their Delegate choice, the Advisors present may determine who will act as Delegate(s). Chapters with only one Active Member registered at the National Convention shall have two votes. If more than one Active Member is registered at the Convention, any and each Delegate will have only one vote. [86 NC; 00 NC; Jul 02]
