- Service should be of a lasting nature
- Service performed may be through a continuing program or through a single, outstanding project
- Service performed by the chapter must incur direct involvement with youth registered in a scouting organization
- The number of youth served by the chapter's program or project will be a consideration in the evaluation of the nomination
- The number of active members of the chapter involved with the program or project will be a consideration in the evaluation of the nomination
- The chapter's entire service to Scouting program must be included for consideration

Presentations may be written, verbal, or visual. Materials may be presented in electronic format (VHS videotape, CD-ROM, or DVD-ROM, all limited to 15 minutes). However, you are responsible with providing the appropriate devices to present your submission (VHS player, CD-ROM drive, DVD player, etc.).
