- Submit a John Mack Scholarship Application, with a statement of purpose of educational and career plans
- Submit a letter of recommendation from a chapter advisor, or another volunteer leader

- Applications should be typed.
- Applications and other enclosures should be sent to the Executive Director, 14901 E. 42nd Street S, Independence, Missouri, 64055-7347.
- Application submission deadline is May 1 or the first business day after if the first falls on a weekend.
- Announcement of the John Mack Scholarship recipient(s) will be made at the end of May.
- Any awards granted will be submitted to the university directly for the benefit of the student.
- Expected awards are a one-time scholarship of at least \$500 per recipient.
